- QuickBooks: need new version -- \$7.50 monthly or \$90 for the first year

Lynn made the motion to approve these additional expenses. Keri seconded the motion. Vote passed unanimously with 11 votes.

2) Should we use Zoom for the IG meeting or stay with Free Conference Call?

Lynn recommended switching to Zoom (Monica can set up account). Questions: Who should pay? Lynn thought since IG was paying, individual meetings could contribute. Mary S. asked what would happen if a meeting date changed? Verna thought that was doable. Susie Y. asked about the name on the account – the answer was <a href="mailto:OAdetroit@gmail.com">OAdetroit@gmail.com</a>. Lynn moved that the IG switch to Zoom. Susie Y. seconded. The motion passed unanimously with 11 votes. Meetings can use the Zoom account. Lynn H. offered to coordinate. Pina will add the IG Zoom link to the website and post that Zoom is available for meetings to use.
